



**Saturday, March 12, 2011 – Semifinals - Game 9
9 Dayton 64, #12 Saint Joseph 61**

DAYTON NOTES (22-12)

- > Dayton is now 19-14 in 16 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship (3-3 in the semifinals) and 10-7 under head coach Brian Gregory
- > The Flyers are the first ninth seed to advance to the Atlantic 10 Championship title game since the league changed the format in 2005-06, eliminating an East and West division
- > The Flyers are now a perfect 18-0 on the year when leading with five minutes left to play in regulation
- > Dayton shot 6-for-17 from behind the arc, the first time in three Atlantic 10 Championship games the Flyers didn't connect on 50% of their long range shots. Dayton is now shooting 50.9% (27-53) from behind the arc in the 2011 Championship
- > Juwan Staten holds the UD record for most starts by a freshman point guard (32)
- > Juwan Staten did not record an assist in the game, the first time all year that he did not have an assist. He has 181 helpers on the year, the third most in a single season for the Flyers. His 5.5 apg average is the best ever for a freshman at Dayton
- > Chris Wright recorded his eleventh double-double of the year, his first in an Atlantic 10 Championship game, with 17 points and 15 rebounds, and the 19th for a Flyer in 2010-11. It was also his 12th double-digit rebounding game of the year
- > Chris Wright did not block a shot today, snapping a streak of 22 consecutive games with at least one block. He has a Dayton-record career total of 159 blocks
- > Chris Wright tied a career-high with five assists (he's done it three times)
- > Chris Johnson netted a game-high 19 points; his second straight and 20th overall double-figure scoring game this year
- > Nine different players scored in the game for Dayton
- > The Flyers outrebounded Saint Joseph's 37-31, the 25th time this year Dayton has outrebounded an opponent (Dayton is 20-5 in those game)

SAINT JOSEPH'S NOTES (11-22)

- > Saint Joseph's is now 32-27 all-time in 29 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship (the Hawks have made the championship every year since joining the conference in 1981-82). The 32 wins are second most in conference history behind Temple (52).
- > Saint Joseph's advanced to the semifinals for the 14th time (1985, 1986, 1987, 1988, 1991, 1993, 1995, 1997, 2001, 2003, 2005, 2006 and 2008) and are 5-9 all-time in the semifinals
- > Saint Joseph's had a three-game winning streak in Atlantic 10 Championship Semifinal games snapped and is now 5-9 all-time in the semifinals
- > The Hawks are the first 12th seed to advance to the semifinals since the league changed the format in 2005-06, eliminating an East and West division (they are also the first 12th seed to ever win a game)
- > Over the past five seasons Saint Joseph's is 26-16 in March
- > The Hawks are now 9-4 all-time at Boardwalk Hall
- > Saint Joseph's outshot Dayton from the field (41.2% to 40.7%), the 13th time this year the Hawks have outshot an opponent (Saint Joseph's is 9-4 in those games)
- > Langston Galloway just missed his first career double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds. The nine rebounds ties his season-high
- > C.J. Aiken recorded three blocks in the game, the 32nd time in 33 games this year he recorded at least one block. He has 117 blocks on the year, a Hawks freshman record and four shy of the school single season record of 121 held by Rodney Blake (1985-86)
- > Carl Jones scored eleven points, his sixth straight double-figure scoring game and his 29th of the year (32 games) and 41st of his career
- > Idris Hilliard netted 15 points, his fourth straight double-figure scoring game and his 15th of the year

A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- > Number nine seeds are now 2-0 in the quarterfinals of the Atlantic 10 Championship since the league changed the format in 2005-06, eliminating an East and West division while this is the first time a 12 seed advanced to the semifinals
- > This is the second time since 2006 that two teams seeded ninth or below (#9 Dayton and #12 Saint Joseph's) have advanced to the Atlantic 10 semifinals (in 2006 #9 Temple and #10 Xavier advanced with Xavier eventually winning the title)
- > Higher seeds are 5-6 in the Atlantic 10 Championship Semifinals since 2006
- > Dayton advances to its third Atlantic 10 Championship final, the first since 2004. Dayton won the championship game in 2003
- > Dayton is the first nine seed to make the Atlantic 10 championship game since the championship format was changed in 2006 (Xavier (tenth) is the lowest seed to win the title since 2006)
