



**Friday, March 11, 2011 – Quarterfinals - Game 5  
#9 Dayton 68, #1 Xavier 67**

### **DAYTON NOTES**

- > Dayton is now 18-14 in 16 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship (7-7 in the quarterfinals) and 9-7 under head coach Brian Gregory
- > The Flyers are the third ninth seed to advance to the Atlantic 10 Championship quarterfinals since 2006 (Temple in 2007 and Saint Joseph's in 2009).
- > The Flyers are now a perfect 17-0 on the year when leading with five minutes left to play in regulation
- > Dayton shot a season-high 61.5% (8-13) from behind the arc, the second straight Atlantic 10 Championship game the Flyers have hit over 50% of their long range shots. Dayton is now shooting 58.3% (21-36) from behind the arc in the 2011 Championship
- > Dayton shot 52.0% from the field, the best shooting percentage for any team against Xavier this year. It is the second straight game the Flyers shot over 50% against the Musketeers
- > Dayton outrebounded Xavier 32-24 and is now 19-5 this year when outrebounding its opponent
- > Juwan Staten holds the UD record for most starts by a freshman point guard (31)
- > Staten's six assists brings his season total to 181, the third most in a single season for the Flyers. His 5.7 apg average is the best ever for a freshman at Dayton
- > Chris Wright has blocked a shot in 22 consecutive games and with his two today now has a Dayton-record career total of 158
- > Chris Johnson recorded his fourth double-double of the year and the 18<sup>th</sup> for a Flyer in 2010-11

## XAVIER NOTES

- > Xavier is now 23-12 all-time in 15 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship. The 23 wins is fourth all-time in conference history behind Temple (52), Saint Joseph's (30) and Massachusetts (30).
- > Xavier had a nine-game winning streak snapped in Atlantic 10 quarterfinal games and is 11-5 all-time in the quarterfinals. The Musketeers' last quarterfinals loss was to George Washington in 2001 (83-74)
- > Xavier was held to under 30 first half points for the eighth time this year (the Musketeers are 2-6 in those eight games)
- > Xavier and Dayton have met three times in one season ten times with each team winning all three games twice (Xavier last year and in 2008; Dayton in 1950 and 1956)
- > Xavier had its nine-game winning streak snapped and is still one win away from its fifth straight 25-win season
- > Junior guard Tu Holloway scored at least 20 points for the 19<sup>th</sup> time in 31 games
- > Seniors Dante Jackson and Joe Hughes have been part of 108 wins, one short of the school record for most wins in a career (Jason Love '10)

## A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- > The one-point margin of victory is the first one-point Atlantic 10 quarterfinal game since Saint Joseph's beat Rutgers, 71-70, in 1993 and is the first one-point game at the championship since Dayton beat Saint Louis, 63-62 in overtime in 2008
- > Dayton is the first ninth seed to advance to the semifinals since Temple in 2006
- > Number one seeds are now 3-2 in the quarterfinals of the Atlantic 10 Championship since the league changed the format in 2005-06, eliminating an East and West division
- > Dayton advanced to the semifinals for the sixth time, the last occurring on 2009 (the Flyers also made the semis in 2000, 2002, 2003 and 2004.
- > Xavier is the second one seed to fall in the quarterfinals since 2006 (George Washington in 2006)
- > Xavier and Dayton have met six times in the Atlantic 10 Championship with the Musketeers winning the first five, including the 2004 championship game
- > The Musketeers and Flyers have met four times in the last five years at the Atlantic 10 Championship, all in the quarterfinals
