XAVIER NOTES

- > Xavier advances to the Atlantic 10 semifinals for the eighth straight season
- > Xavier is now 23-10 all-time at the Atlantic 10 Championship
- > The Musketeers have now won eight straight and 12 of their last 13
- > Jordan Crawford, who entered the game leading the Atlantic 10 in scoring with a 19.7 ppg average, netted 22, his second straight 22-point game and the 16th 20-point game of the year
- > Terrell Holloway scored a game-high 22 points, his fourth 20-point game of the year
- > Xavier is now 4-0 when playing on Fridays
- > Jason Love recorded his eighth double-double of the year with 17 points and ten rebounds
- > Xavier made 33 of 41 free throw attempts, both season-highs, led by Terrell Holloway who was nine-for-ten from the charity stripe, to increase his Atlantic 10-leading free throw percentage to 85.2% (127-149)
- > Xavier connected on only three three-pointers, a season-low (previous season-low was four against Rhode Island and at Florida) while the Musketeers 20.0% field goal percentage matched their season-low (at Florida)
- > The Musketeers recorded seven assists, one more than their season-low of six against Kansas State

DAYTON NOTES

- > Dayton recorded a season-high 13 steals, led by four from Rob Lowry, one shy of his career-high
- > Chris Wright netted 17 points, his 26th double-figure game this year
- > Wright tied Kurt Huelsman's season-high for the Flyers with four blocked shots

- > Kurt Huelsman started his 132nd consecutive game, a Dayton record and the sixth longest active streak in the NCAA Division I
- > London Warren brought his streak of games with at least one assist to 67
- > Eleven of the 12 Dayton losses have come to teams in the Top 100 of the RPI
- > Marcus Johnson finished with a team-high 18 points, the third time in the past four games he finished in double figures
- > The Flyers have now dropped their past five road games against nationally ranked opponents

A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- > Number two seeds are now 2-3 in their first game of the Atlantic 10 Championship since the league changed the format in 2005-06, eliminating an East and West division
- > The win was Xavier's 22nd in 14 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship
- > Xavier and Dayton have met five times now in the Atlantic 10 Championship with the Musketeers winning all five, including the 2004 championship game
- > Xavier head coach Chris Mack is looking to become the fourth head coach to win the Atlantic 10 title in his first year as head coach, joining Thad Matta (Xavier – 2002), Roy Chipman (Pittsburgh 1981) and Bob Wentzel (Rutgers – 1989). Matta is the only coach in league history to win a regular season and tournament title
- > Xavier is the only team to have three different coaches lead it to an Atlantic 10 title (Thad Matta, Sean Miller and Skip Prosser)
- > The Flyers were whistled for 33 fouls, just two shy of the Atlantic 10 Championship record of 35 set by Pittsburgh against Villanova in 1980
- > The two teams combined for 54 fouls, seven short of the Atlantic 10 Championship record of 61 set by Saint Joseph's and ST. Bonaventure in 1995
- > Xavier made 33 free throws, tied for the fourth most for a team at an Atlantic 10 Championship game (the record is 39 set by St. Bonaventure in 198 and matched by George Washington in 1984)
